**Lesson #1** — Even a just cause can be <u>twisted</u> to bring out the <u>apple-eater</u> in us.

**Lesson #2** — Rest brings with it the opportunity to reflect and <u>see what God is up to</u>.

**Lesson #3** — God puts in us His love for <u>justice</u>, which is different than <u>judgment</u>.

Lesson #4 — When we are <u>enslaved in our mind</u>, being chased by fear or failure, we are not free to be the <u>fullest</u> <u>expression</u> of who God made us to be.

**Lesson #5** — God calls us to <u>set aside</u> things that keep us stuck.

**Lesson #6** — God is <u>aware of our situation</u> and seeks to bring us into His good and spacious place.

**Lesson #7** — Often, the very thing we've <u>buried so deep</u> has the greatest <u>redemptive potential</u> to bring freedom!
