STORY... "Jesus is like bread"

FAITH IN JESUS means I look past and look through (or I risk missing it)...

- ↳ Blessing to the blessor, provision to the provider
 - ↳ Personality to Him
 - ↳ Movement is supposed to MOVE ME

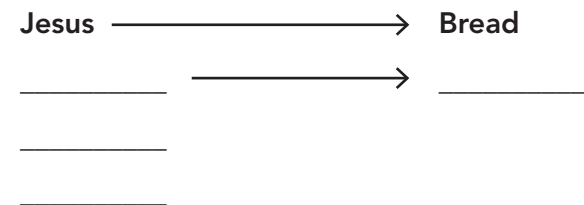
